Joseph O'Brien runs two and although Aeon's Aegis has shown some ability, a chance is taken on SWEET BAY to improve on her turf debut stepping down in trip. The filly wasn't far behind the now 110-rated California Dreamer (runs in the Jersev Stakes at Roval Ascot today) at Dundalk when last seen and should improve Next in line is Rallydoyle's Alfred Tennyson who can be expected to relish better ground, while Famed Again and Knockmark are respected.

Children under 14 years will not be permitted in the Parade Ring.






AGE AWARE

HORSE WELFARE -A PRIORITY

At every race meeting there are specially qualified equine veterinary surgeons on duty to look after the wellbeing of all the horses racing. There is a vet in attendance at the start of each race who, follows the horses throughout the race and is quickly on hand if a casualty occurs. It is normal procedure to erect screens around any horse receiving veterinary treatment. This allows the veterinary surgeon some privacy to fully assess the horses' injuries and race goers should not assume the worst if screens are erected around an injured horse. The Blue Cross ambulance is always present to transport the horse back to the stable yard for further treatment if necessary.

A second veterinary surgeon is in attendance in the stable yard to assess and treat any horses requiring such attention post race.

The horses' welfare is always our priority.


